## COLD CALLERS

Be wary of all cold-callers offering to do work on your home, as they can offer overpriced or unnecessary services, or put pressure on residents to agree to the work, as has happened on this occasion. Traders must give you a written quote from the business address, which should include a 14-day cancellation period before the work starts. You should always use recognised companies or people who have been recommended to you by a trusted source.

Police always recommend using a door chain and asking to see the identification of unexpected callers.

- if you are suspicious of a caller ring 999 straight away
- keep your cash in the bank, not at home
- keep windows and doors secured if you're not in the room

- expect you to check their identification before opening the door
- would never try to rush you by claiming there's an emergency
