## Offences that were not proceeded with FOI 420/13

Please Note:

- A Notice of Intended Prosecution must be received by the registered keeper of the vehicle within 14 days of the offence.
- 'Other' reasons offences were not proceeded with include:
  - **Date of birth not found** this occurs with drivers whose licenses are registered abroad. Their date of birth will not be on the DVLA record.
  - Negative response from DVLA
  - The registered keeper / driver is deceased
  - Registered keeper / driver in prison
  - Liquidation when the vehicle is registered to a company which has subsequently stopped trading
  - **Excused** normally, the applicant would have to elect to attend court to explain any mitigation, but in clear-cut cases about which they can provide proof, the case can be cancelled
  - Statutory time limit to prosecute expired
  - Emergency vehicle on 999 or Blue Light call
